



- Draw attention to your business, enhance the visibility of your activity, and create confidence through partner, advisor and investor recognition.
- Find investors to raise capital, meet your future partners: other companies, key accounts, research labs, etc.
- Gain as many contacts as possible to support you, particularly with other firms supported by key organizations.
- Enjoy a service where your data is safe and will not be sold to third parties.
- Simplify the capture of your company's data in a single place with the possibility of carefully managing your levels of confidentiality.



Impact* of the **EuroQuity** approach

Considerable propensity to increase capital

36% of registered companies raise capital within five years of registering with EuroQuity. Most of these companies raise capital within 18 months of registering

At least 415 million Euros raised since the creation

Total capital raised on the 2,293 EuroQuity companies publishing their balance sheet amounts to €415 million.

One third of companies that raise capital repeat the operation within five years

Propensity to raise capital is up to 72% higher when a firm belongs to a network

EuroQuity's flagship service consists in enabling companies wishing to raise capital to indicate their belonging to a network (or "label") on the site. This is visible to all investors and can be a sign of confidence for attracting new ones. Propensity to raise capital is 38% higher where a company is associated with one label and 72% higher where there are two labels or more

Capital-raising operations that generate significant business growth and jobs


Companies present on EuroQuity that raise capital record stronger growth than those that do not increase their capital. This is confirmed both by sales figures +12.6% and headcounts +6.3%




EuroQuity – promote the quality of support structures

A label is a sign of confidence







 - Give access to information and data regarding their markets
 - Advise for the benefit of the final users and organization partners, in particular if needed to validate a new « label » or community »
